SEASIDE REFLECTIONS

JANE STODDARD

July 13 – August 16, 2017

The Copley Society of Art is proud to present *Seaside Reflections*, a solo show of watercolor paintings by Jane Stoddard in the Red Room Gallery and Boston Private’s Prudential Center branch location. This exhibition opens with a reception on Thursday, July 13th from 5:30 to 7:30pm at the Copley Society, located at 158 Newbury Street, Boston, MA 02116, and continues through August 16th.

In *Seaside Reflections*, Stoddard portrays several Cape Cod marine subjects that she hopes will “transport the viewer to similar scenes that they have encountered in their lives, allowing them to experience a sense of place and familiarity.” For Stoddard, boats and seaside scenes are some of her favorites to paint because they “create beautiful abstract patterns that move and shimmer, almost with a life of their own.”

Stoddard is often drawn to depicting subjects with strong compositions such as boats, markets, and architecture scenes. In *Seaside Reflections*, Stoddard paints scenes of rowboats and their surrounding landscapes while vividly detailing water reflections, surfaces, and textures. The magnificent images evoke a strong sense of place, portraying scenes of beached rowboats and crowded docks, which are reminiscent of the Cape Cod locale. With *Seaside Reflections*, Stoddard hopes that her paintings not only encourage further insight toward maritime compositions, but that we are reminded of our own past experiences at seaside locations.

The Copley Society of Art (Co|So), America’s oldest non-profit arts organization, is committed to the advancement, enjoyment, and promotion of its member artists and the visual arts. The organization, founded in 1879, comprises juried artists who are selected by a credentialed art committee. Co|So provides artists with a gallery for exhibiting and selling their work and a platform for engaging and educating the community.
