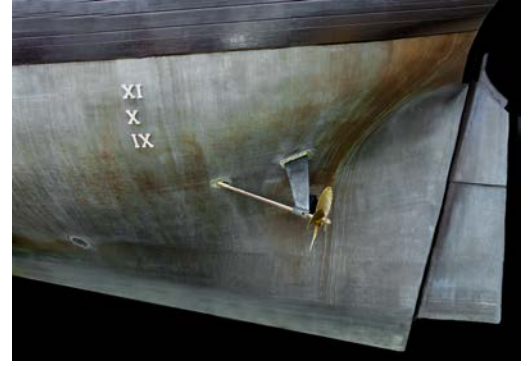
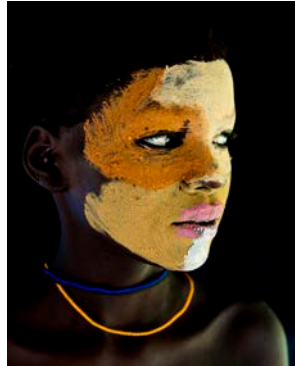

## **ELEVATED**

### **NATIONAL PHOTOGRAPHY SHOW 2018**

September 15 – October 3, 2018

*What elevates a photograph to fine art?*

The Copley Society of Art is proud to present *National Photography Show: Elevated*, a showcase in the Upper Gallery that features fine art photographs by CoSo artist members and non-members. This exhibition opens with a reception on Saturday, September 15 from 5:30pm – 7:30 PM at the CoSo Gallery, located at 158 Newbury Street in Boston, and continues through October 3.

Juried by Robert Klein Gallery owner Robert Klein, *Elevated* includes a range of photographic subjects and styles that explore the question: what elevates a photograph to fine art? First Prize was awarded to Michael Sterling for *Period Piece*, a photograph of a near-empty deteriorating abode. Second Prize was given to Doug Adams for his portrait *Tribal Expression*, and Third Prize was granted to Juan Murray for his black-and-white photograph *Lafayette & Co.* Sally Bousquet's *Deep End*, an underwater photograph, was chosen as the Juror's Choice.
