The Copley Society of Art is proud to present the annual juried Summer Members Show, a showcase in the Upper Gallery that features a wonderful variety of works by our artist members. This exhibition opens with a reception on Thursday, July 13th from 5:30 to 7:30pm at the Co|So Gallery, located at 158 Newbury Street, Boston, MA 02116, and continues through August 11, 2017.

This year's show, *Summer Hours*, includes a range of styles and mediums such as painting, photography, graphite, and mixed media. Co|So is grateful to have Hope Turner and Zola Solamente of Arden Gallery jury this year's Summer Members Show. First prize was awarded to Todd Montanaro's oil painting, *Watching and Waiting*, which captures the pensive mood of two onlookers observing the ocean tides. It was also awarded the Alden Bryan Memorial Award for Traditional Landscape Painting in Oil. Second prize was given to Kat O'Connor for her oil painting, *Light Above*, which beautifully plays with the light and colors of a woman submerged in water. Third prize was awarded to Julian Cherubini's *Blue Sea*, a digital print of the endless stretches of blues between sky and ocean.

The Copley Society of Art (Co|So), America's oldest non-profit arts organization, is committed to the advancement, enjoyment, and promotion of its member artists and the visual arts. The organization, founded in 1879, comprises juried artists who are selected by a credentialed art committee.
