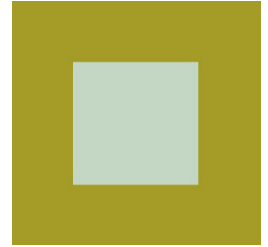


CALL TO STUDENT ARTISTS

Copley Society of Art's 26th Annual Student Show

Deadline for Submission: **January 12, 2018**

Exhibition: **March 8 - April 19, 2018**



The twenty-sixth annual Student Show is a juried exhibition open to all art students in New England, aged 18 and over and enrolled full-time in a studio arts program at the undergraduate level. The jury will consider work from all genres and styles including photography, painting, printmaking, and sculpture. Please review the criteria below for submission information.

Eligibility Requirements and Entry Instructions Artists must be 18 years or older and enrolled full-time in a studio art program at a New England college or university.

Please submit digital images of original artwork, saved on CD as jpegs at 300 dpi resolution along with a Jury Entry Form (available on our website).

Artists may submit up to three pieces of any medium for consideration by the jurors. All images must be received by Friday, January 12th.

All work exhibited at the Society must be available for sale at a fair retail value. Once chosen, each piece must be appropriately framed and ready for hanging with eye-screws and hanging wire attached. All 3-D work must include installation instructions.

Notification Artists whose work is accepted will be notified by January 30. Drop-off dates for accepted works is: February 23-25. Unless otherwise requested, all submission materials will become part of the artist's personal member file at ColSo.
