

THE ROBERT C. VOSE JR. & ANN PETERSON VOSE SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE STUDY OF AMERICAN ART HISTORY

This generous **\$4,000 scholarship** is offered annually to one university student who has best demonstrated a commitment to the study of American Art History and a determination to advance scholarship in a specific realm of this field.

To be eligible for this prestigious award, the student (undergraduate or graduate level) must be an Art History major with a focus on American Art, currently enrolled full time at a regional college or university and must be nominated by the Head of his or her Art History Department.

If interested, please let your faculty advisor or department head know that you wish to be nominated, and prepare a letter of no more than two pages describing your interest in American Art and what you hope to achieve academically during the coming year.

We require the following application materials: 1. A letter from the head of your Art History department or your faculty advisor. The letter should detail academic achievements, personal characteristics, and also take both need and motivation into consideration. 2. A transcript of your academic courses and grades to date. 3. A letter from you (the nominee) of no more than two pages describing your interest in American Art and what you hope to achieve during the academic year.

All submissions from faculty, including the above letter, transcript, and recommendation, must be submitted by **January 12, 2018**. Applications can be submitted in person or mailed to: Aly Schuman, Gallery Coordinator, Copley Society of Art, 158 Newbury Street, Boston, MA 02116. The winner of the Vose Scholarship will be honored and presented with the award at the Copley Society of Art's *26th Annual Student Show* award reception on March 8, 2018.
